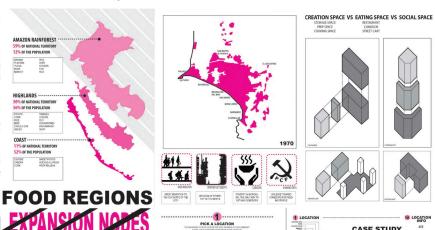

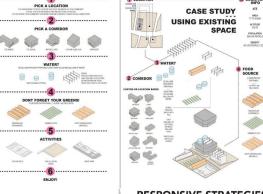
Phase 1: Research + Mapping

time.

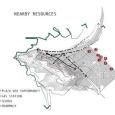
Phase 2: Observation + Interaction

Perú, with IntuyLab and Alto Perú Surf (Below Left). Phase 3: Design of systems, examples



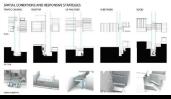
